PAGODA DOGWOOD Cornus alternifolia

Upright tree with horizontally layered branches. It has interesting clusters of creamy-white flowers, followed by dark blue berries.



PINKY WINKY® HYDRANGEA Hydrangea paniculata 'DVP pinky'



1.25 m / 4' Sully-October cpbr#2889, uspp#16166



Very large and showy flowers begin a creamy-white, then transforms to a rich pink in the fall. Rounded growth habit is easy to maintain.




LIMELIGHT HYDRANGEA Hydrangea paniculata 'Limelight'

This early blooming hydrangea flowers about a month before other hydrangeas. White flowers transform to pink-red as summer progresses. This dwarf plant fits easily into any landscape, including container gardens.



**BLUE CHIP JUNIPER** Juniperus horizontalis 'Blue Chip'



1 m / 3' ↔ 1 m / 3'

A top grafted form creating a unique design element in the landscape. Prune annually in late spring to maintain desired length.





1 2 m / 6' ↔ 2 m / 6'

Cascading form with soft green needles in spring creates a stunning garden accent. Train to desired height.





## WEEPING WHITE SPRUCE Picea glauca 'Pendula'

1 2 m / 7' ← 1.25 m / 4'

Gentle weeping form with attractive strong blue needles is perfect for creating a corner accent. Train to desired height.



## GLOBE BLUE SPRUCE Picea pungens 'Glauca Globosa'



1.25 m / 4' ↔ 1.25 m / 4'

A top grafted form creating a lollipop effect. Great for accenting small spaces. Shear annually in late June to maintain desired size and form.



# **WEEPING PUSSY WILLOW** Salix caprea 'Pendula'



1.25 m / 4' ↔ 1.25 m / 4'

A weeping selection with silvery, wooly catkins appearing in spring before the foliage. In summer plant is covered the lustrous green leaves.



## DWARF KOREAN LILAC Syringa meyeri 'Palibin'



A slow growing selection with a dense, rounded habit. Small rounded foliage is covered by numerous lilac-pink, fragrant flowers.



## MISS KIM LILAC Syringa patula 'Miss Kim'






This later blooming, rounded lilac has long panicles of purple buds opening to the single icy-blue flowers. Great fall colour adds to any landscape.





A compact, upright tree. Showy flower clusters followed by dark bluish-black edible berries.





SNOWBALL VIBURNUM TREE FORM Viburnum opulus 'Roseum'



1 2.5 m / 8' ↔ 2 m / 6' May-June



Masses of large, white, snowball-like flower clusters. Glossy, bright green leaves have a purplish-red fall coloring.
