

Deer Resistant Plants

Landscaping with deer resistant plants is the most aesthetically pleasing way to combat deer problems, as there is no fence to block views or get in the way, and no repellent you have to continually buy and apply all over your landscape or garden.

There are few plants that are entirely 100% deer resistant. Anytime you see the phrase resistant attached to garden plants it doesn't mean a plant won't be attacked or eaten just that the chances are reduced. The plants listed here are less appealing to deer, however if they are starving they will still eat them.

Deer repelling plants should be planted among your other plants, or around the perimeter of your landscape. Deer resistant plants must equal 40% or more of your plants to have any significant effect.

The selection of Deer Resistant plants we have provided is not a fully comprehensive list, there are many other varieties that are deer resistant. The provided list is only for items we commonly carry.
